Please review this scene with your child and complete the checked items :

## Questions:

- 1. What did the teacher tell the students to do?

- 4. When the teacher tells you to say, "Thank you" to a visitor, what should you do?  
What are some things you could say to a guest or visitor to let them know you're happy they came?
- 5. Think of a time you said, "Thank you" to someone special. Were they happy you thanked them? How did you know?

## Activities:

- 1. Point to one student who said "Thank you." Draw a firefighter helmet on his/her head.
- 2. Draw an "X" above the student who forgot to say, "Thank you" to the guest.
- 3. Draw a picture of yourself in the scene. What would you do?
